CHARBON STEAKHOUSE

Located in the beautiful Gare du Palais, Charbon Steakhouse welcomes you in a sublime room with its 30-feet high ceiling, the unique architecture and decor, that all contribute to the restaurant's flamboyant character.

When entering the venue, you soon notice their imposing bar set in the center of this huge room, just in front of a 20-feet high extractor hood hanging over the grill and their expert grillers. Then you know that you just set foot in the authentic steakhouse of Quebec. Comfortable bench seating for 4 to 15 people spread along the walls, a bar offering a variety of fine spirits, cocktails, imported beers, and an extensive wine list and the service by attentive staff. DINNER TRANSPORTATION

When needed, we usually transfer the groups with city buses to their venue. These buses can contain 44 seated guests and have space for people standing.

The city bus can move more easily in the narrow streets of Old-Quebec than a motor coach and in a short period. They are also very clean and more affordable than motor coach.

GOLFING OPTION

Golfing opportunities abound in Quebec, with an impressive array of courses at every turn: near the city, in the mountains, by lakes and rivers. GRAND VALLON GOLF CLUB (MONT-SAINTE-ANNE)

The course features 6,583 yards of impeccable fairways from the back tees, challenging tree-lined stretches, wide open mid-course sections, four lakes and 40 pure white sand traps.

Only 35 minutes from Quebec City, Le Grand Vallon is a beautiful, smoothly rolling 18-hole, par 72, set against the breathtaking backdrop of Mont-Sainte-Anne. This golf club covers an exceptional site which includes three artificial lakes. The entire golf course and the restaurant have been refurbished and improved, which make it a top-quality site. The scenery is breathtaking; the service is impeccable and the challenge is great. You will be more than pleased.



WALKING TOUR OF OLD QUEBEC

DISCOVERY OF ÎLE D'ORLÉANS – A GOURMET TASTING EXPERIENCE

Here are **some examples** of places that could be visited during the tour:

MONTMORENCY FALLS PARK

Located just a few minutes from the Old Quebec, Parc de la Chute-Montmorency is an attraction you will not want to pass up. The waterfall is an awe-inspiring 83 m/272', a full one and a half time higher than Niagara Falls. You can admire stunning views from the cable car, from the many lookout points throughout the site or from the stairs climbing up the side of the promontory.



SUGAR SHACK L'EN-TAILLEUR

To discover the Sugar Shack tradition, L'En-Tailleur offers a guided visit of its installations during which you learn all about the history of maple syrup. For the meal, typical Quebec dishes includes marinades, homemade bread and creton, soup, ham, beans, ragout, pork, sausages, and other traditional foods like maple sweets. A festive atmosphere is created by the sound of violin, guitar or songs. Maple taffy on snow on the program.

CASSIS MONNA AND FILLES

Has been synonymous with passion and innovation since 1992. The company has mastered the art of transforming black currant – harvested on the Île d'Orléans – into products of the highest quality, including a *crème de cassis* that earned various awards.



CIDRERIE BILODEAU

The Bilodeau Cider House is specialised in miniature and semi-miniature apple trees. The family-owned orchard of over 3000 trees and has mastered since 1982 the art of Ice Cider, re-establishing the popularity of this amazing and well-adapted fruit. They have recently been awarded for their 2015 edition of "Le Breuvage des Dieux" (Beverage of the Gods).

VIGNOBLE DE SAINTE-PÉTRONILLE

Discover and taste the richness of Sainte-Pétronille's local delicacies. Come share a moment with the owners of this fabulous vineyard that faces the Montmorency Falls, adding to the already perfect scenery. White, red, grape Mistelle and ice wine are available. Tasting, interpretation, and a terrace are waiting for you.
